**NOTICE**

**Subject: Modification in Scheme for Financial Assistance for Veteran Artists.**

Consequent upon EFC recommendations and approval of Competent Authority for continuation of the various schemes under the umbrella scheme of Kala Sanskriti Vikas Yojana (KSVY) beyond 31.03.2021 for a period of 5 years i.e., upto 31.03.2026, the following modifications have also been approved in the Scheme :-

- (a) The nomenclature of the Scheme will now be '**Financial Assistance for Veteran Artists**'
- (b) **Financial Assistance** for each beneficiary shall be @ Rs.6,000/- (Rupees Six Thousand only) per month and @ Rs. 5,999/- (Rupees Five Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Nine only) per month in case of transfer of Financial Assistance to spouse on the death of initial beneficiary.
- (c) Income Certificate in the prescribed format issued by the concerned Competent Authority of the States/UTs is required to be submitted once in *Every Five (05) Years*.
- (d) The artists applicant should submit a recommendation letter from the concerned **Zonal Cultural Center (ZCC), Ministry of Culture** along with the application in respect of **Artist belonging to those States/UTs where there is no provision of Artists Pension in the prescribed format.**

**Note:-** The revised rate/revised guidelines of the scheme will be **effective from 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2022 onwards.**
